## Proposed increase in student numbers at Lutterworth High School

As a school, we are consulting on an increase in our student numbers. The intention is to allow for 175 students in Year groups 7 – 11, compared to our current 150 Published Admissions Number (PAN). This would be subject to securing funding for additional teaching spaces, via a **Condition Improvement Fund Expansion** bid.

There is a significant demand for places and the current facilities do not enable us to offer spaces for 175 students in each year group. The improved facilities would include a new dance studio, changing rooms and additional classrooms. If the expansion bid is unsuccessful the school will revert to a PAN of 150 students.

In summary the aims of this official expansion are:

- to address the significant demand for entry in Year 7 and allow 25 more families to secure a place for their child in Year 7 year on year. This will create an overall additional 125 places at the school.
- to provide teaching and learning facilities for 175 students in every year group, including changing rooms for dance and an improved dance studio.
- to continue to provide outstanding educational provision for the local community.
- to allow a broad and balanced curriculum, with a wide degree of choice at GCSE.
- to address crowding issues in some classrooms.
- to improve the flow and movement of students around the site.
- to allow students with physical needs to fully access the dance curriculum.

The consultation will run for six weeks and as an interested party at Lutterworth High School, we are keen to hear your views on the proposed change. Therefore, we invite you to participate in the consultation.
